Thank you for applying for admission into the Master of Accountancy in Taxation (MAT) Program. Please note that the admission test will be held at 02:00PM, Friday, 18 May 2018, in the Exam Hall#506, Academic Building, Faculty of Business Studies, University of Dhaka. You are requested to be present in the exam hall at least 15 minutes before the test begins.

We will ask you to read the following useful instructions for the admission test:

1. The test is comprised of three sections carrying 70 Marks in aggregate. This is a 90-minute test.
2. Section-I is a Quantitative Aptitude Test and consists of 25 questions carrying 1.2 Points each. It is designed to test your content and analytical knowledge of basic math concepts, including arithmetic and number properties, algebra, and geometry. Questions are generally of problem solving type. Problem Solving questions use high school-level mathematics up to algebra and plane geometry to test a candidate's critical thinking skills.
3. Section-II is the Verbal Section and consists of 25 questions carrying 1.2 Points each. The Verbal Section is intended to test an applicant's command of standard written English, his/her skill in analyzing arguments, and ability to read critically. You will find three question types in Section 2 and they are respectively Sentence Correction, Critical Reasoning, and Reading Comprehension.
4. A question of either Section-I or Section-II will have five (A, B, C, D, & E) possible answer choices. You shall indicate the correct answer in the OMR sheet. No MCQ Question shall have more than one correct answer. The Verbal Section includes 5 questions (Questions 21 through 25) that need to be answered in the designated space of the Test Booklet.
5. Section-III is a Writing Assessment carrying 10 points. Write a clear, logical, and well-organized response to an issue or argument. Your response should be in the form of a short essay, following the conventions of standard written English. Write your essay in less than 500 words (Approx.) and write it in the designated space.
6. Invigilators will monitor the Admission Test and applicants shall comply with their instructions. As the test time expires, wait for the invigilators to pick up both the Text Booklet and OMR Answer Sheet. Do not leave your seat unless instructed by the invigilators.
7. Do not carry any mobile phone, calculator and/or electronic gadget in the exam hall.

We wish you all the best in the scheduled Admission Test of the Master of Accountancy in Taxation (MAT) Program.
